SBOE Candidates for District 6 include Donna Bahorich and Traci Jensen. You will have the opportunity to learn about the SBOE governing body and hear how the District 6 candidates plan to improve education in Texas. Scott Brogan, of the Brilliant Lecture Series, will moderate the conversation.

The State Board of Education (SBOE) is very influential. Because its duties include curriculum and textbook approval, it determines what every student in Texas public schools must learn from kindergarten through high school. Since Texas adopts textbooks statewide, this decision determines what textbook publishers will print, so this also impacts the entire nation.

Members of the Texas State Board of Education (SBOE) are elected in partisan elections decided during the state's general election cycle. All 15 seats on the board are on the ballot this November because of redistricting. District 6 encompasses Harris County- west of I-45. Despite the importance of these elected positions, information about candidates for the state board has traditionally been very limited.
